Shari Allison Rosen was born and raised in Old Bethpage, New York, and moved to Baltimore in 1984 to study Voice at the world-renowned Peabody Conservatory of Music. She has earned both her Bachelor (1988) and Master (1991) of Music Degrees in Voice Performance from the Peabody, studying with William Ray and Phyllis Bryn-Julson.

Shari has performed numerous operatic roles including Donna Elvira in Mozart's Don Giovanni and The Female Chorus in Benjamin Britten's The Rape of Lucretia. In addition, she has performed numerous solos with chorus and orchestra, including the Poulenc Gloria and Mendelssohn's Lobgesang. Shari has extensive experience in Jewish liturgical music. She has sung in numerous synagogue choirs in the Baltimore area, including Baltimore Hebrew Congregation, Temple Oheb Shalom and Har Sinai Congregation. Never just 'another voice in the choir,' Shari's Jewish music experience grew to include her working as a Cantorial Soloist at Baltimore Hebrew Congregation and, most recently, at Temple Beth Israel in York, PA.

Professional development opportunities in Jewish music have brought Shari to the Simi Valley in California to attend the Brandeis Collegiate Institute as a Music Fellow, as well to Cincinnati, Ohio for a summer at Hebrew Union College's Mifgash Musicale.

Her involvement in Baltimore's Jewish community has also included her work as an Administrative Assistant for the Immigrant Division of Jewish Vocational Service of THE ASSOCIATED: Jewish Community Federation of Baltimore, as well as her current position as Administrative Assistant for the K-12 congregational religious school programs at Chizuk Amuno Congregation.

Shari is looking forward to a vibrant and exciting spiritual venture as Cantorial Soloist with us at Congregation Shalom Aleichem and welcomes the opportunity to share her musical talent and love of her Jewish heritage with our members.

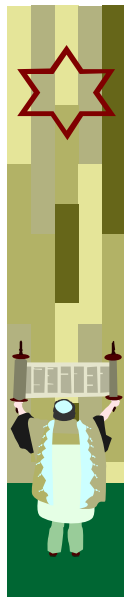
